Climbing On Trucks Without Using The Access Platforms IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED

Trucks must be staged under the access platform so that the access gangway fits directly over the hatch opening

TO USE THE ACCESS GANGWAY

1. Release the gangway securing pin
2. Push the gangway down so that it rests on top of or parallel to the truck top
3. Open or close hatch while remaining inside the safety rails
4. **DO NOT** step outside of the safety rail system while on the top of the truck
5. Pull the gangway up after exiting top of truck
6. Reattach the gangway securing pin
